**Call for submission of proposal for organization of Conference/Seminar/Workshop/Popular Talk
in the field of Science & Technology**

Bihar Council on Science & Technology (BCST), Patna invites proposals from the recognized institutions/universities/departments of the state for organization of Conference/Seminar/Workshop/Popular Talk under the scheme "Assistance for organization of Seminar, Workshop in different Institutions" of Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education, Government of Bihar. The topic should be aligned with the mandate of BCST (relevant to Science and Technology).

General institutions excluding Professional Institutions (Technical/ Medical/Agriculture/Animal Husbandry) will be eligible to receive the grant provided they have got at least Grade 'A' of NAAC.

The proposals must be submitted in the prescribed format duly forwarded by the Head of the institution. The application format, guidelines and details of support can be downloaded from the BCST website www.bcst.org.in. The application should clearly mention of detail of the resource persons and their letter of consent of participation. Initially 50% of the sanctioned amount will be released to the beneficiary institute. The balance amount will be released only after submission of audited utilization certificate and statement of expenditure, activity report, abstract book, souvenir, photographs, newspaper clippings etc. Participation of students of organizing institute in terms of Poster Presentation/Innovative Model must be ensured and same must be submitted in the report.

All the proposals will be evaluated by the Screening Committee. The soft and hard copy of the proposals in prescribed format must be submitted by registered/speed post only **latest by 08.09.2025**. However advance copy can be sent on email pd@bcst.org.in. All particulars entered should be same as in the hard copy.
